Dear Residents/ANC/Local Businesses/Property Managers:

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will begin an alley improvement project in your neighborhood, which will include concrete/brick alley paving on or about Wednesday, November 6, 2019, weather permitting. We will be doing it in sections.

Exact Location: *Alley bounded by 1231 Massachusetts Avenue, S.E., East Capitol Street, S.E., 13th Street, S.E., and Kentucky Avenue S.E. (Square 1013).* The contractor is authorized to work during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Saturday. It is estimated that this work will take approximately three (3) weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Once the work begins, the areas under construction will be closed, parking will not be possible while work is underway. Pedestrians and vehicles will not have access to private property that is entered from the alley. **“EMERGENCY NO PARKING”** signs will be posted seventy-two (72) hours prior to the beginning of any construction work in your area. In emergency situations access may be possible by notifying our on-site DDOT inspector/contractor or by calling the number below.

Residential: Trash will be collected along the front of your property until the completion of the alley project. Trash will not have to be separated. If your trashcan is too cumbersome to handle, please use thick trash bags and place them in the public space in front of your property. This action is being coordinated by DDOT with the Department of Public Works (DPW). All questions regarding trash pick-up must be directed to DPW at 202-576-9000 or 202-576-9054.

Commercial: DDOT will move smaller dumpsters for pick-up, and place them back in the same place after the work is completed. If you have a large dumpster, please alert your hauler about this work activity, and have them to contact DDOT at 202-671-2700, to mitigate any impact on your trash pick-up services.

If weather conditions, schedule changes or unforeseen issues do not permit our contractor to begin this work on the date stated above, the new start date for construction will be posted on the Emergency No Parking Signs located in the alley throughout the construction project site.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but we hope that the improved alley will make this temporary inconvenience worthwhile.
